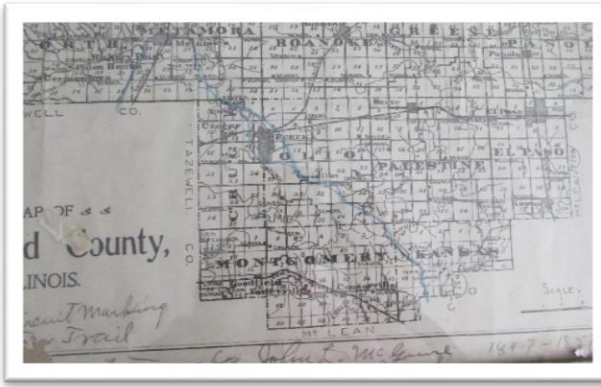
Old Woodford County Jail - Metamora

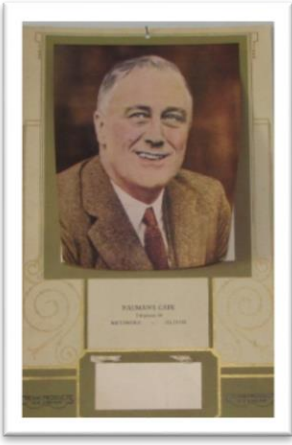

Old Livery Stable (Phone Company Location)

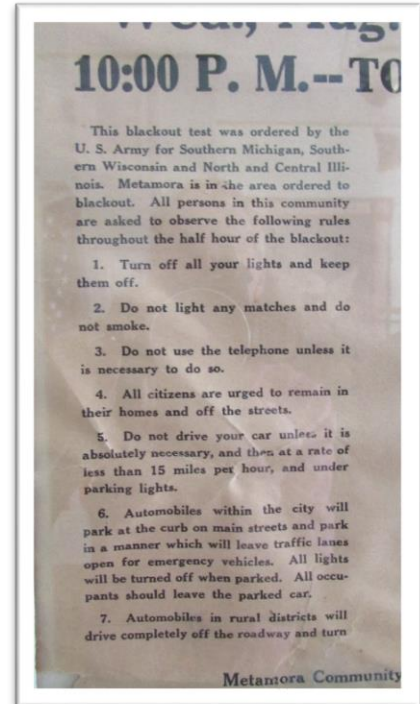


Metamora House – Where Lincoln Stayed
