#### **Metamora Water**



**1889**. When the first volunteer fire department was formed, the village constructed the original tower where Casey's is today.

**1912**. The city replaced the 16 foot wooden tank on that tower, which had become unsafe, with a duplicate of the original.

The contract called for work to be completed within 12 days after the tank was drained at a cost of \$1,000. Capacity was 50,000 gallons (compared to today's capacity of 200,000 gallons.)

The tower was made of brick, one foot thick and 100 feet tall. The replacement tank was 16 feet tall and made of white pine.

**1960**. The current tower was built. In April, **1962**, the old tower was razed.
